Vancouver Campus Committee Halloween Event Proposal Chair: Juvina Silvestre October 4th, 2017

Due to a lack of fun and engaging student-oriented events/activities on Vancouver Campuses, specially at the SFU Harbour Centre Campus, our committee has decided to host one/two movie nights featuring highly rated horror movies and free food. This is a causal and free event where students from all programs could gather together in celebration the Fall season and may dress up in their favourite Halloween costumes. As a committee, we sense a strong need to bring more positivity and fun experiences to students who have classes at the Vancouver campuses or live in downtown, making Burnaby events less accessible. We decided to draw up to \$300 for our first event from the Vancouver Campus Committee Line Item (822/20) which was allocated \$5,000 for the duration of the year.

Vancouver Campus Committee Engagement Proposal Chair: Juvina Silvestre October 4th, 2017

This year, the Strategic Engagement Committee has come up with a plan to promote a fun atmosphere to engage with our membership through weekly events (e.g., Freebie Friday, Freezie Friday, Timbit Tuesday, etc). As a result, the Vancouver Campus committee has decided to follow the structure of this initiative and host similar mini events at Vancouver campuses. We will draw up to \$500 until December 31st to test of the effectiveness of this initiative at Vancouver campuses, from the Vancouver Campus Committee Line Item (822/20) which was allocated \$5,000 for the duration of the year.

- This year's committee has committed to spend most of our funds on student outreach activities mainly at the Vancouver campuses through consistent engagement hours, themed events, and a pub night. Since we previously approved the expense of a new banner which cost \$300, we will have \$4,200 remaining for other activities.
- This will promote opportunities for the board to interact with its members, provide something to look forward to every two weeks, and most importantly obtain membership input in general as well as initiatives or events that the board or Vancouver Campus Committee is currently working on.
- Our committee will host at least one-hour long engagement activities bi-weekly on Wednesday afternoons from 2-3PM. Each session requires at least two members of the committee in order to proceed. A session could be cancelled with notice to the board if this requirement is not met under extenuating circumstances.
- Location: SFU Harbour Centre Campus and Woodward's
- Exception: seasonal holidays based on the SFU academic calendar

Although it is not required, board members who are not voting members of the Vancouver Campus Committee are strongly encouraged to attend at least one of these weekly engagement opportunities.
