Description: The four Independent Electoral Commission [IEC] Commissioners will be responsible for supporting the coordination of elections, by-elections, and referendums that adhere to all related policies, by-laws, and regulations of the Society.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Take direction from and support the IEC Chief Commissioner
2. Support outreach campaigns to promote the SFSS elections and referendums
3. Support the administration of complaints and inquiries related to the SFSS elections and referendum
4. Maintain office hours as directed by the IEC Chief Commissioner
5. Other duties as required

Required Skills and Experience:

1. The IEC Commissioners shall be active members in good standing of the Society, except that no current member of or candidate for the Board, Council or a Faculty Student Union may serve as a member of the IEC
2. Strong communication skills, writing and word processing skills, as well strong attention to detail and organization skills
