6.1 MOTION BOD 2019-08-01:03

Whereas widespread protests have been taking place in Hong Kong for several months, a city that for historical reasons maintains separate legal and political systems from the rest of China. These protests, which have escalated significantly since May, were sparked by the introduction (and later suspension) of a highly controversial bill allowing judicial extradition from Hong Kong to the mainland. The tumult has inspired solidarity protests in universities around the world, including SFU, and there has been heated debate between pro- and anti-protester camps that has at times devolved into physical altercations and attacks on protesters, as during incidents in Australia and New Zealand;

Whereas there have been repeated incidents of vandalism and harassment at the site of the SFU "Lennon wall" protest, which have drawn concern in the campus community and recently been reported in national news. However, it needs to be pointed out that by no means are international students from Hong Kong and mainland China neatly divided into separate and opposing blocs on this or other issues. In addition, it is not appropriate at this time for the SFSS to take a stance without being adequately informed of the geopolitical implications of the current unrest. Despite this, our members should be able to protest and freely express their opinions on the situation in Hong Kong without drawing retaliation in the form of threats, harassment, bullying or vandalism. This resolution thus supports the right of SFU students to do so without fear; Be it resolved that the Simon Fraser Student Society stands firmly in support of the right of all Simon Fraser University students to peacefully, respectfully and freely express their views

Be it further resolved that the Simon Fraser Student Society condemns any attempt to censor or dissuade through threats, harassment or bullying such expression;

Be it further resolved that the Simon Fraser Student Society publicly announce this resolution in a timely manner.
