### **Terms & Conditions**

### **The Application Process**

Interested vendors must submit the completed form with payment to the SFSS Student Centre at msc.events@sfss.ca. The SFSS Events Coordinators will jury all applicants and select artisans based uniqueness of products amongst other applicants and seniority of the vendor. All successful applicants will then be notified and payment will be processed. Payments can be made by cash, credit card or cheque made payable to the Simon Fraser Student Society.

#### Merchandise

All goods and/or services to be sold and/or promoted must be disclosed at the time of booking. It is the vendor's responsibility to notify the SFSS of any changes to merchandise or service prior to vending date. All changes are subject to approval by the SFSS, failure to do so can result in immediate cancellation of vending permit and no refund will be granted..

The Winter Craft Fair is held in the busy North Concourse of the Academic Quadrangle (AQ) at the Burnaby campus of Simon Fraser University. As the main lecture building on campus, this area receives an abundance of foot traffic as student, staff, and faculty make their way to their next appointment.

The Fair runs during peak hours from 10:00am to 4:00pm, Tuesday through Thursday. Vendors may stay past 4:00pm at their discretion.

#### Vending Space

- Vendor table allocations will be arranged and artisans notified approximately one week in advance of the fair. Table arrangements are solely at the discretion of the SFSS Coordinators and cannot be disputed.
- Table locations are assigned with consideration of the flow of the fair. The SFSS provides one 8 x 2.5 foot tables, 2 chairs, and access to SFU wireless Internet. The SFSS is not responsible for any disturbance to the wireless network.
- If you need a power there is an additional charge.
- If additional space is required, vendors will need to book two spots and pay the associated fees.
- Vendor booths, tables, chairs or signs may not block any doorways, fire equipment, elevators, or alarms.

#### Security & Overnight Storage

Tables, chairs, signage, and display systems may be left on site. The sale area will have dedicated security patrolling the fair from closing hours to opening hours. However, SFU, the SFSS, and/or SFU Security will not be responsible for any theft, loss, or act of vandalism. Vendors are responsible for covering their displays and for removing and storing any articles they wish to be secured. The SFSS is not responsible for any loss or damage to vendor products, equipment and signage.

Parking is an optional fee. Vendors may choose to buy single or multiple Day Passes. Day Passes give the vendor access to any visitor parking lot on campus. An updated map will be available upon request. Parking passes are non-refundable. Please read the instructions on the parking pass. A parking map is available on the SFU Parking website.

#### **Cancellations and Refunds**

Booking cancellations are admissible up to one week prior to the start of the event, with a full refund of the registration fee. After this deadline, the registration fees are non-refundable.

#### **Loading and Setup Times**

The Strand Hall loading bay offers the most direct and level access to the Winter Craft Fair; however, there are only a few temporary loading parking stalls, so please come early to do your initial set-up. Please see map for location. Vendors must complete the set-up no later than 10:00am.

#### Advertising

The SFSS may advertise and promote the Winter Craft Fair both to the campus and local community through posters, online sources, social media, and campus banners. Emails and flyers will also be distributed to all campus departments.

### Compliance

Vendors found not in compliance with Fair policies will not be permitted to participate in the Winter Craft Fair. No refunds will be granted if this is to occur.

### The SFSS reserves the right to:

- Limit the sale of similar merchandise to two vendors.
- Restrict sales of goods that are already being provided to the student body by other SFSS or SFU services (such as food products).
- Limit the total number of student vendors.
