## 6. DISCUSSION

# **6.1 Discussion with the Auditor regarding the SFSS Fall Kick-Off Budget** Background:

- A student presented at the Board Meeting on November 29<sup>th</sup> about the expenditure of the Fall Kick-Off 2019 concert and suggested that the Board has a forensic audit.
- The student also presented at the Council meeting held on January 22<sup>nd</sup> asking the Council to advise the Board to do the audit.
- On January 20<sup>th</sup>, there was an article in the Peak about the Fall Kick-Off 2019 concert which stated that the concert has resulted in a deficit of \$105,995.



#### Discussion:

- Gary Wozny, SFSS's External Auditor, was invited to the Executive Committee meeting to advise whether the SFSS should have a forensic audit.
  - o He pointed out that when organizing an event of this scale, it is difficult to know what the revenues are going to be before the event takes place.
    - There is always the risk of having a loss when the revenues are not as expected.
  - o A forensic audit is usually done when it is suspected that there may be fiscal mismanagement, fraud, misappropriation of money etc.
  - O A forensic auditor can also look at the process of organizing the event for example if the bylaws were followed.
  - o In the case of the Fall Kick-Off 2019 concert, there was confusion with the \$60000 SFSS sponsorship:
    - Initially, the budget was \$15,000;
    - In August, the Board approved an additional \$45,000.
      - There was an emergency meeting to approve the increase in the budget.
      - The question about whether there was sufficient discussion before approval, resulted in the recommendation for a forensic audit.
        However, the Finance Manager has all the cheque authorisations and signed contracts.
      - A lot of discussions also took place via the Slack channel and there are records of these conversations.

- It was brought out that this issue about the Fall Kick-Off 2019 concert is not issue that should be solved by a forensic audit;
  - o It is more about the question of getting external advice.
- In addition, it was suggested not to have such an event of this magnitude, since it costed too much. Other events can be organized to engage students
  - o It is not possible to get the type of artists that would attract students with only \$15,000, rather it would cost about \$200,000.
  - o It was suggested to engage students in a different way.
