## 7. DISCUSSION ITEMS

### 7.1 COVID-19 Academic Advocacy & Potential Summer 2020 COVID-19 Survey

- Data from COVID-19 surveys found that students were struggling financially and academically due to the following:
  - Lack of a stable internet connection
  - Lack of a space without distractions to focus on academics
- Some SFSS Board members are also on the SFU Senate
  - Heading into the Fall semester, the Student Senators are applying pressure to SFU to create a policy around asynchronous learning
- Exam proctoring/invigilating recording raises many privacy issues
  - o It can be very stressful and anxiety inducing for many students





- VP University Relations would like to send out another survey to students around their struggles with COVID-19
  - o This survey would collect data about the Summer 2020 semester
  - Faculty of Science representative said that a survey would not be the most effective, as SFU administration has already discredited a previous survey
  - o A student at-large member suggested an open letter to SFU administration
- Committee raised concerns regarding student who do not feel comfortable putting forth their name in a potential petition or open letter
  - O Anonymous signatures for a petition would be a way to combat this issue
