| | Create a By-Law titled "SFSS Administrator Cost Restrictions" 1. An administrator's "hourly wage equivalent" cannot be more than 2.5 times the hourly wage of a "student staff" as defined and established in the most recent Collective Agreement for the SFSS's unionized employees. 2. The combined salaries of all administrators, excluding the cost of benefits, shall be no greater than 10% of the total revenue from the General Fund or \$300,000, whichever is larger. 3. Legacy employment contracts for administrators are excluded from the wage caps established in subitems (1) and (2). | | |
