6.2 Lobby Days Topics and Date

- Provincial Lobby List
 - o International Tuition Affordability Met with Anne Kang to talk about this and will put it in the lobby days to talk bout it.
 - International Student MSP Will try to make it eliminated for international students for affordability purposes.
 - Sexual Violence and Misconduct Prevention Lobbied by ABCS, and the committee is in contact with ABCS and wants to work together. SFSS has separate lobby for this as well.
 - Increase Funding for Operating Rent Consulate with various organizations to lobby and make emphasis on how important this is.
 - Accessibility Through Legislation Came out of consultation from the government in 2019 as introduction to accessibility legislation as BC has no such legislation. Currently haven't heard anything about the bill and isn't progressing so SFSS is trying follow-up on this.
 - Research Based Data Collection Will be put in lobby and ask for it to be pushed through as COVID-19 has impacted marginalized communities.



- Abolish Police and Redirect Funds SFSS is trying to push government formed committee called Special Committee on Reforming Police Act to abolish police rather than them only focusing on reviewing role of police within mental health, wellness and harm reduction initiatives.

- Sarah will work on a report with more details for each topic that MLAs will be provided with for the actual meeting.
- Dates for Provincial lobbying will be during March 22nd to March 31st.
- Members let Samad know which topics are of interest to them.
 - Yulia on Sexual Violence and Misconduct Prevention.

International Student Tuition Affordability

The Simon Fraser Student Society (SFSS) is a student-led non-profit organisation that represents over 25,000 undergraduate students across the three campuses of Simon Fraser University (SFU) in Burnaby, Vancouver and Surrey, British Columbia. Our mission is to support students in reaching their full potential by providing resources that represent, connect and benefit our membership.

International students attending post-secondary school in British Columbia face increasing tuition fees that are not currently capped by the Tuition Limit Policy that applies to domestic students. Tuition and ancillary fees can rise by as much as twenty percent yearly, leaving international students increasingly vulnerable to financial instability and unpredictability. Furthermore, without the proper notice and time frame of these fee increases, students may face the risk of being removed from their courses and the country. The SFSS would greatly appreciate meeting with you to discuss ways international student tuition in British Columbia can be fairer and more transparent. International students already face many barriers including navigating Canadian financial systems, entering the labour market, and lacking support systems, and having to opt-out and enroll in both an extended healthcare plan and government healthcare plan can be a large challenge for students already facing these barriers. Sexual Violence and Misconduct Prevention Working Group Support

In 2016, the provincial legislature passed Bill 23, *The Sexual Violence and Misconduct Policy Act*, which provided a mandate for post-secondary institutions to establish and implement a sexual violence and misconduct policy. However, new reporting and resource requirements that place a financial burden on smaller institutions, coupled with a lack of oversight and accountability procedures provided in the *Act*, create a gap in effectiveness of this legislation between schools in B.C. Increase Funding for Operating Grants

The Simon Fraser Student Society (SFSS) is a student-led non-profit organisation that represents over 25,000 undergraduate students across the three campuses of Simon Fraser University (SFU) in Burnaby, Vancouver and Surrey, British Columbia. Our mission is to support students in reaching their full potential by providing resources that represent, connect and benefit our membership.

Post-secondary institutions have been facing stagnant and even decreasing annual provincial operating grants over the last few decades. In 1979, nearly 90% of operating revenue for B.C. post-secondary institutions came from federal or provincial sources, compared to just 47.4% from both levels of government in 2018. In 2015, tuition revenue surpassed provincial funding as the main source of operating revenue for SFU, putting an unsustainable financial burden on students. The SFSS would greatly appreciate meeting with you to discuss the possibility of increasing operating grants and re-evaluating the funding model.
