

Psycho-Educational Assessment Funding

STEP 1

THE ASSESSMENT

Find a licensed/registered psychologist to administer the assessment, make the payment out-of-pocket, and obtain an itemized receipt.

STEP 2

FUNDING ELIGIBILITY

Do you qualify for StudentAid BC Funding?
Do you have a financial need?
Are you a domestic student?
Does your assessment diagnose a specific learning disability?

STEP 3

Complete Sections 1 & 2 of the StudentAid BC Permanent Disability Application Form.

STEP 4

Contact CAL to complete Section 3 of the form.

STEP 5

Contact your psychologist from **Step 1** to complete Section 4 of the form and submit the completed form to StudentAid BC. You may be reimbursed 75% up to \$1,700.

STEP 6

If government funding **does not cover the entire cost**, please proceed to the beginning step of SFSS funding.

Privately Funded (SFSS)

STEP 3

Complete the Health Claim Form, available on the Studentcare website, and submit it to Pacific Blue Cross with your itemized receipt.

STEP 4

PBC will reimburse you for the remainder of your psychology benefits and/or send you an Explanation of Benefits (EOB).

STEP 5

Send copies of all your documents from **Steps 3 & 4** to Studentcare (psy-ed@studentcare.ca).

STEP 6

Studentcare and SFSS will process your application and complete the Extra-Contractual Cost Plus Claim Form. If approved, SFSS will issue payment through PBC to reimburse you (up to 80%, to a maximum of \$3,000).
