
5. DISCUSSION ITEMS

5.1 Introduction to Committee and Counsellors

• VP Equity and Sustainability mentioned that this would be a general introductory meeting without the use of Robert's rules. She emphasized that this space should be a space where Councillors feel comfortable to work on campaigns that are passionate about and ensure that marginalized communities at SFU are being included.

5.2 Projects and Initiatives Counsellors Are Working on Relevant to the Committee

- Chair brainstorm a Strategic Plan led a brainstorming session.
- Criminology Councillor suggested reducing palm oil on campus.
- English Councillor suggested pushing for more veggie options on campus and looking into the Blenz coffee that will be located in the SUB to ensure foods are ethically sourced.
- IAT Councillor suggested including biweekly infographics in bathrooms to educate people on different forms of oppression, how they exist, and why they exist. Goal of this project is a more inclusive campus.
- Chair expressed interest in having an info board about forms of oppression in the SUB.
- VP University and Academic Affairs suggested increasing community care to avoid using campus public safety (ex. Mental health crisis or need naloxone, peer instead of campus public safety). They mentioned the need to provide training and build community capacity.
- Several Committee members raised issues surrounding the SFU Sustainability office which is no longer centering student voices when it was created by student advocacy.
- Key Areas to focus on for the 2021-2022 year include:
- Increasing programing by the Women's Centre and Out On Campus.
- Increasing accessibility for Disabled students and increasing student access to Health and Counselling Accessibility (particularly increasing resources for mental health).
- Increasing Indigenous Student Support and focusing on Indigenous issues (settler-colonial issues that affect Indigenous folks). Encourage Student Unions to have Indigenous student representatives.
- Pushing for Divestment and supporting the Climate Emergency Declaration Letter as well as collaborating with Students Against TMX. Supporting the Referendum questions on Divestment.





- Implementing a long-term Food Hub.
- Making CAL more accessible, increasing support for ADHD students, and lower thresholds for accommodations.
- Advocating for spaces for students, building community specifically for trans/nonbinary folks at SFU and broader LGBTQ+ community.
