Question	<p>SFSS HEALTH AND DENTAL PLAN</p> <p>Whereas the Simon Fraser Student Society (SFSS) provides services and resources to the SFSS membership; Whereas the SFSS Health and Dental Plan was launched in 2008 with no mechanism to increase the fee to keep pace with inflation, except via referendum;</p> <p>Whereas the SFSS Health and Dental Plan is one of the most utilised services by the SFSS membership, and has seen significant increase in claims year over year; Whereas students have expressed interest in additional mental health support and the proposed f adjustment allows for the SFSS to expand mental health service offerings;</p> <p>Whereas students will retain the option to choose a lower level of coverage at a lower cost (Basic Plan), or opt out completely if they have equivalent alternative coverage; Whereas SFSS has exhausted other avenues to manage plan costs without cutting benefits:</p> <p>Knowing that you can opt-out completely with alternative coverage or reduce your coverage for a lower cost, do you consent to raise the SFSS Health & Dental Plan Fees by \$31.92 for the policy year starting September 1, 2023 and authorize SFSS Council to adjust the Plan Fee by up to 5% annually (only when needed) starting September 2024, to account for inflationary impacts on Health & Dental services?</p> <p>Note: If passed, the Health & Dental plan fees for Sept 1, 2023 would change as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enhanced Plan: From \$267.08 to \$299 per year • Basic Plan: From \$207.40 to \$239.32 per year
