interest in helping with the surveys.

- Campaigns and Mobilization Coordinator suggested that the people who elected themselves to work on the survey could meet and try to set deadlines since most students will start enrolling in August to have something to show the administration to plead the case with the University before the fall semester.
- Philosophy Councillor stated that summer was a good time to do the survey as well because there are fewer options for enrollment in the summer too.
- Campaigns and Mobilization Coordinator suggested completing the survey in the summer and the fall. If it is done for the summer and the University's solution is not great, It can be presented again in the fall in time for the Annual General Meeting and rally students to support this.
- VP University and Academic Affairs suggested Postponing this discussion to the next UAA Meeting to which everyone agreed to.
