- The RHA Councillor mentioned that this motion is to obtain a freezer for the SFSS for the current food initiative that is been going on.
- The Campaigns and Mobilization Coordinator mentioned that having the freezer would help. They mentioned that seeing the current prices, they are not sure if what is being requested in the motion would be enough since this motion is being brought up from the previous year and prices do fluctuate.
- The RHA Councillor agreed that the freezer cost can be expensive.
- One of the At-large Student members recommended to increase the cost from \$500 to \$1000 as for food security and for storing all items we would require a big freezer.
- The RHA Councillor mentioned that looking at the Best Buy website currently they are offering a mini freezer at \$300.
- The Environmental Science Councillor mentioned that under \$500 we can get a small square fridge and they suggested to wait for our VP External to see what size they are actually looking to get.



- One of the At-large Student members mentioned that we should also look at the quality of the fridge rather than just seeing the price as this would be used for long term.
- The RHA Councillor suggested that we can approve this motion for now and if more is needed then, this motion can come back and our VP External can share if anything else needs to be done as if they suggested \$500 they would have already done some research before putting forward this motion.
