Whereas StormHacks is a 24 hour hackathon being held by SFU Surge on May 18/19, 2024;

Whereas SFU Surge has successfully ran the event annually three times since 2021;

Whereas StormHacks is SFU's largest hackathon and only Major League Hacking (MLH) accredited hackathon at SFU and 1 of 2 in BC (the other being UBC's NWHacks);

Whereas StormHacks has secured ~\$5500 in external sponsor funding this year and lowered consumable costs significantly through partnerships with RedBull and Steves Poke Bar;

Whereas StormHacks previously brought in sponsors such as SAP, BGC Engineering, Teck, HSBC, Intact Insurance etc., and judges with a software engineering or Director background from Amazon, Microsoft, EA, Paypal, Plotly, Salesforce, DWave, and more;

Whereas SFU Surge was able to host and successfully run the event in 2023 in the SUB with over 170 hackers, 20 mentors/judges, and 6 workshops during its return following the Covid-19 pandemic;

Whereas SFU Surge is hosting the next iteration of StormHacks for 250 students this year and hope to continue its tradition;

Whereas they are requesting \$18,703 of funding to support StormHacks 2024;
